Cookie statement

Innovation booster Global B.V. (hereafter: Innovation Boosters) uses cookies on this website. A cookie is a very simple file that is sent along with the pages from this website and is stored by your browser on your computer, tablet or telephone. The information stored can be sent back to our servers on a subsequent visit. There are two types of cookies: session cookies and persistent cookies. The difference is that session cookies are removed from your computer as soon as you close the web browser. Persistent cookies remain on your computer until they reach their expiration date or are deleted.

Collecting cookies

Below is an overview of which cookies we collect:

- **Functional Cookies:** These cookies are necessary for the website to work properly. They help ensure that every time you visit our website it shows the information correctly.
- **Preference cookies:** These cookies ensure that our website can remember information about the structure and behavior of the website. Think of things like the language institution or the region where you are located.
- **Statistical cookies:** These cookies we use to see how visitors use our website. This data is collected and reported anonymously.
- **Marketing cookies** These cookies we use to see who visits the website and what they view. Based on this, our employees can contact you and make targeted offers.

Third party cookies

- **Google Analytics:** A cookie is placed via our website by Google, as part of the statistical service. We use this service to keep track of and get reports on how visitors use our website.
- **Twitter, Facebook and LinkedIn:** Our website includes buttons of Twitter, LinkedIn and Facebook on our website. These buttons work by means of pieces of code that come from LinkedIn, Facebook and Twitter itself. Cookies are placed through this code.

Delete cookies

You can delete cookies and refuse the placing of new cookies via the browser settings on your computer. The way you can do this differs per browser. More information about switching on and off and removing cookies can be found by using the Help function of your browser. Disabling cookies only affects the computer and browser on which you perform this

action. If you use multiple computers and/or browsers, you must repeat this action for each device you have.

Collecting and storing data

At Innovation Boosters we keep the following data of you:

- Gender
- Company
- Company information
- Function
- Telephone number
- E-mail address
- Office address
- Information you freely provide us
- Information from cookies

Legal bases and purposes

The following legal bases are applicable for the information we collect and store as mentioned above:

- Contractual agreement
- Legal obligation
- Legitimate interest
- Free, specific, informed and unambiguous consent

The following purposes are applicable for the information we collect and store as mentioned earlier:

- Provision of services and products
- Contacting our offices
- Visiting this website and social media
- Internal operations
- Financial administration

Access to data

The collected and stored data is only accessible for those who need to work with the information. We only pass on the information to other parties if it is really necessary for our services. For example our payment partner and IT service providers.

In suspicious situations, we are required to share customer data with government agencies. Where necessary we have Data Processing Agreements in place. According to relevant laws, Innovation Boosters is obliged in some cases to provide personal data to third parties. We never sell your data to third parties.

Within Innovation Boosters we use the need-to-known and need-to-use principle for access to information.

Storage and protection of data

Your data is stored securely in a cloud environment. Your data is stored within the EU if you are a European citizen. For American citizens, information is stored in the US.

We always apply strict security measures to protect our and your information in our organization. These measure can be organizational or technical. To prove we take the security of information seriously, we are becoming ISO27001 certified for our whole organization. This includes taking measures on an organizational, technical, human level. When we become ISO27001 certified, you can see the certificate including our Statement of Applicability on our website.

We do not store your information for longer than is legally permitted and necessary for the realization of the purposes for which the data has been processed. How long certain data is kept depends on the type of personal data and the purposes for which they are processed. When the terms have expired, your data will be deleted and destroyed in a secure manner.

Rights of data subject

As a data subject, you have rights with regard to your own personal data. This concerns the following rights:

- **Right to information:** You have the right to receive information about the manner and why of the data processing. This applies to personal data being collected from yourself and when this is collected via others.
- **Right of access and copy:** You have the right to request your own personal data that is known to us, for which purpose this data is used and with whom this personal data is shared. You also have the right to receive a copy.
- **Right to correction and supplement:** You have the right to supplement and/or have your data corrected.

- Right to erasure: You have the right to delete data about you (data erasure). This request must be granted in the following cases, among others:
 - The personal data are not necessary for the goal they have been collected for
 - The personal data has been unlawfully processed
 - You withdraw your consent (if the processing is based here)
- Right of limitation: Your right to request the processing of your personal data (to stop using the data), if one of the following applies:
 - You dispute the correctness of the personal data; processing is restricted for the period that we need to verify the accuracy of the personal data
 - The processing is unlawful and you oppose the erasure of the personal data and instead request that its use be restricted
 - We no longer need the personal data for the original processing purposes, but you need it for the establishment or substantiation of a legal claim
 - You object to the processing and have made in preparation of the answer to the audit trail question outweigh your own.
- Data portability: You have the right to data portability. This means that you have the right to obtain your personal data, which you have submitted to us, in a structured and common digital file. In addition, you have the right to transfer that personal data to another organization, without being hindered by us.
- Right to object: you can ask us to stop using your personal data in the event of:
 - Direct marketing
 - If you object to the processing due to a specific situation.
